DIRECTOR REPORT

- Michele Lee discussed the publicly funded projects, privately funded projects
- Cory Driscoll- The text is completed and the proposal needs to be improved.
- Joelle Dillard in regards to the Courthouse said that the scope of the review, this is government speech, do we need to get that verified by a constitutional expert.
- Cory Driscoll asked because the government is speaking does the art selection panel have the overall approval? Joelle Dillard answered that she wasn't sure.
- Kat Wright explained the process in Chattanooga- government process for an art selection panel.
- David Faliszek asked if there is a government agency that says there's an additional step: will there be another layer of review or the decision of the panel? Joelle Dillard responded that this was uncharted territory.
- Ylva Rouse expressed concern over how calls for proposals are currently being handled. It could be we set it for when there is a certain amount of budget.
- Cory Driscoll suggested that in the January meeting that if you want the process changed for future art projects (ASP) it can be discussed then.
- City Council District Enhancement Project for Public Art. Kat Wright presented Councilmembers' DeFoor project allocating \$41,000 to each of the 14 City Council Districts. Kat will report either in January or February direction of the project after meeting with all the district Council members.
- San Marco Intersection project was discussed by Kat Wright. Full closure for 4 nights got approved by the City. On January 2nd they are doing a soft wash, after that they will begin taping and painting by the artist Ansley Randall.
