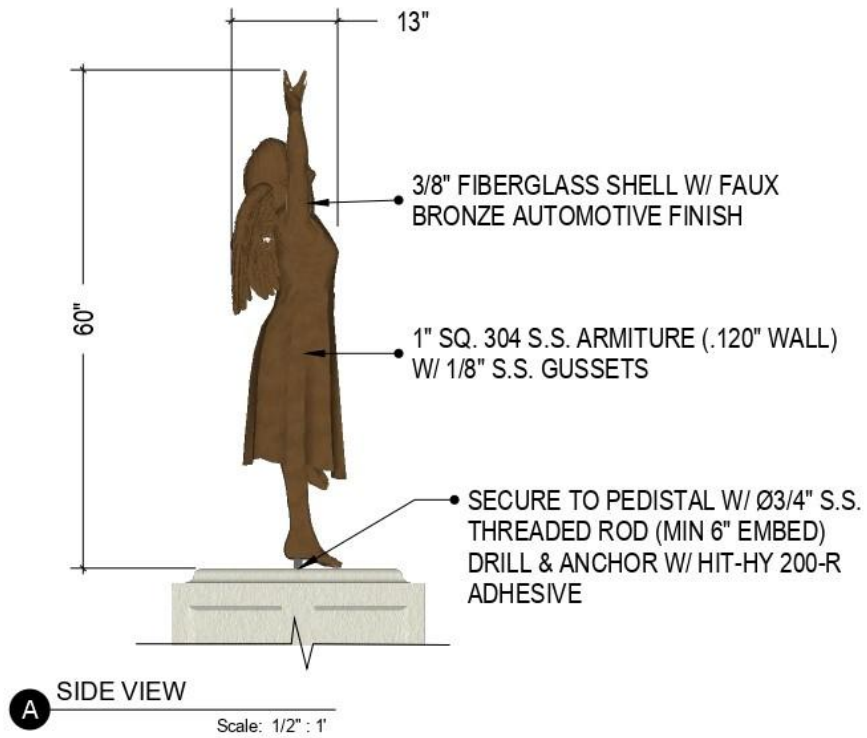
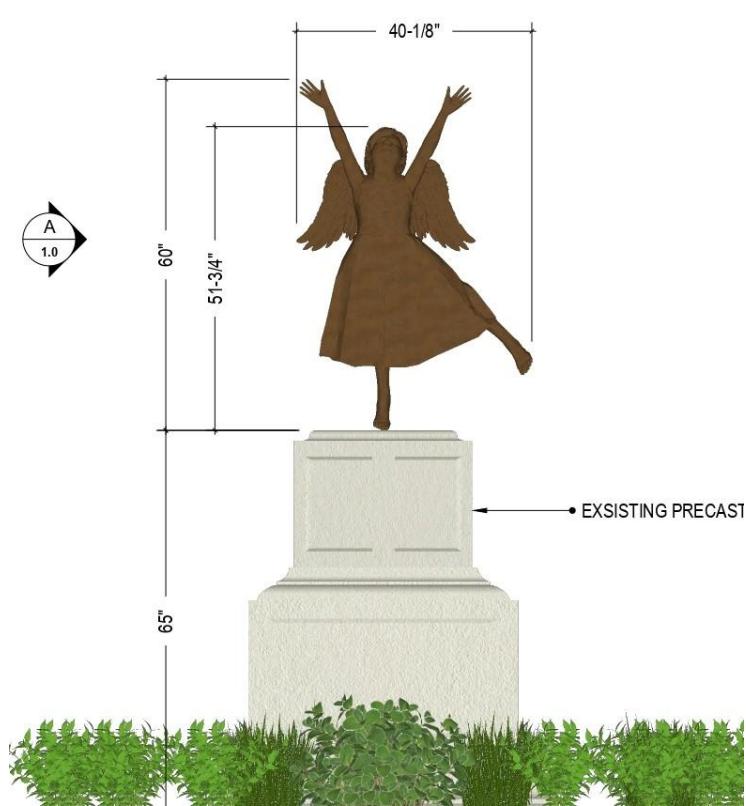


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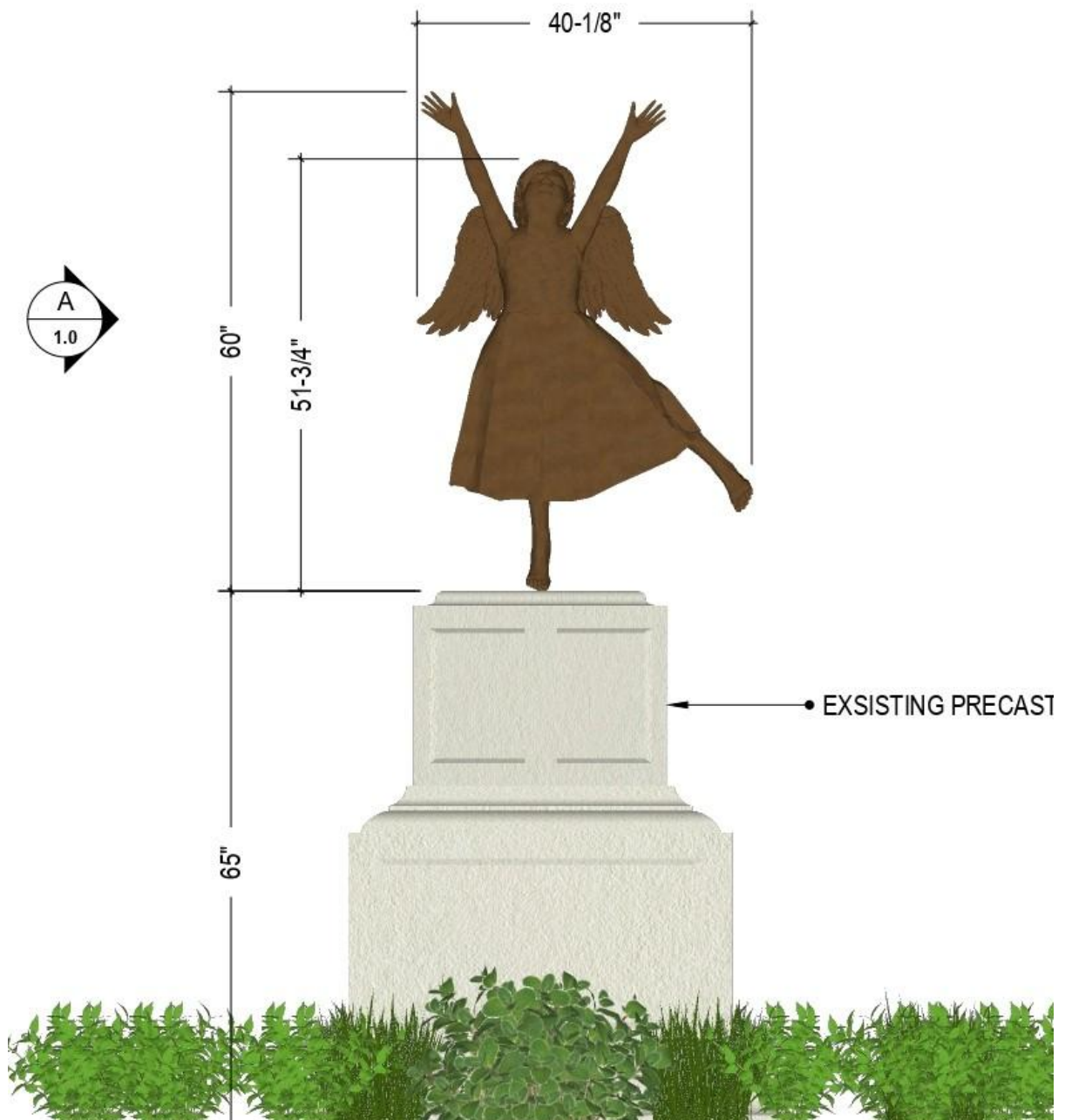

# SHAWANA BROOKS

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Shawana Brooks (1979) is a poet, storyteller, and burgeoning artists' and cultural advocate. Her story is one of reinvention, renewal, and optimism in the face of hardship. Formerly she worked at the Jacksonville Public Library as the Arts and Culture Developer for their initiative the Jax Makerspace located Downtown in the Main Jacksonville Public Library. In her current role, she serves as the Executive Director, Creative Director, and Curator of the Moving the Margins Artist in Residence space in the Corner Gallery located in the Jessie Ball duPont Center. She has learned lessons in listening, seeing, and organization.

In 2015, after she was touched and almost destroyed by personal tragedy, she decided to pursue the dreams of an artists' life she and her painter husband (Roosevelt Watson III) share.

As an artist's manager and as a creative voice in the community, Shawana is interested in advocating for the arts— specifically for minorities and women. In this capacity, she tries to shape a picture of progression and inclusion; and how that narrative builds a community of diversity and equity. She has taken the dream-crafting aspect of make-up and glamour, and is applying it to the imagination-to-reality aspect of working as an artist. Her areas of expertise include networking, curating, and motivation. Shawana's goal is to ensure that artists have the creative opportunity and means to live and function as any successful business. She's doing this through connectivity, partnerships, and tireless championing of the power of art to transform lives and communities.
