**Call to Order:** Christina Parrish (Chair)

### **Welcome**

Christina Parrish, Chair of APP Committee, introduces Executive Director of MOCA, Caitlin Doherty. Ms. Doherty shares that legislation was passed that allows for the sale of Joan Mitchell's "IVA" through Christie's in May. Fifty percent of the sale earning will go to MOCA for maintenance care of MOCA's collection and the remaining fifty percent will go into a maintenance trust fund for the Art in Public Places collection. The artwork's estimate value is two million dollars.

### **ACTION ITEMS**

### **OLD BUSINESS**

**APP Project Report** – Projects are on hold and the topic of artists contracts will be returned to in future meetings. DIA Phase II Call for Artists has been issued and the project was kicked off during Public Art Week with a public meeting hosted by MOCA. The DIA Phase II deadline is May 10. APP met with judiciaries on Law & Liberty project--we will move forward with a reinstallation design if the donor approves the project.

### **Public Art Week:**

Public Art Week took place April 1<sup>st</sup> – April 7<sup>th</sup>. APP worked closely with Shawana Brooks with Jax Makerspace at the Main Library to give a tour of public art throughout the library. Lea Mahan participated on this tour. FIA Phase I has some updates that took place during PAW--Jenny Hager's

*Urban Flora #1&2* were relocated to the Kid Zone of Hemming Park due to some issues caused by the original location for local business owners. The DIA Phase II Pre-submission session was hosted at MOCA and included a panel for question and answer session by DIA Phase I artists Cecilia Lueza and Andrew Reid SHed and Christina Parrish. Two other public art tours took place-- one in Hemming Park on Art Walk and the Elbow District for the DIA Phase II and the second in the Urban Core.

## **NEW BUSINESS**

### **Planning District Six:**

Two potential candidates to fill the Planning District 6 seat are present to speak to the committee on serving Kim Kimberly and Jason Peoples. Kim Kimberly is a visual artist and singer working at Johnson & Johnson. Jason Peoples is the Program Director for Jacksonville Arts and Music School (JAMS). JAMS serves third-seventh grade students and programming includes visual arts, culinary, music, film, and dance.

### **42nd Annual Arts Awards:**

Tony Allegretti, Director of CCGJ, speaks on the details of the Arts Awards. The event will take place May 5 at TIAA Bank Field. Al Letson is the Emcee for the evening and the programming will follow a seating dinner during the award announcements. The Castano Group will have an installation on the screens. Ticket prices are \$175 and lower ticket prices may be available through patrons ticket donations--there is a waitlist for lower ticket pricing.
