#### **Welcome: Art Critique- 4 basics to evaluating Art**

There are four steps to evaluating art; description, analysis, interpretation, and judgement. Analysis includes lines, shapes, colors, values, textures, and space. Judgement is not about whether or not you like it, but whether or not the artist conveyed the information they were trying to share. The APPC Members critiques two pieces of artwork to exercise similar critiques that will occur in an art selection panel meeting.

#### **APPC Five Year Plan goals and objectives - collective experience**

We want to be collaborative and fully innovative. We will work on developing the vision throughout the next five years. Maintenance and conservation, Ordinance policy, Community outreach and education are priorities that will be dissected. Duval County Schools wants to integrate APP into the school system, but we have to adjust our curriculum to
